Person Responsible for Success

- Make sure your UE Customer Success Agent has the right point of contact who will manage UE Live! games at your community.



Best Practice

Typically your staff member responsible for resident activities

Uninterrupted access to the internet

- Wi-Fi networking strength should be strong enough to carry live-streaming content.
 - Suggested Wi-Fi speed is at least 1 Mbps
 - Unsure of your Wi-Fi speed? Use a site like www.speedcheck.org to run a quick, free test.
- Zoom access will be provided to you through UE for your games.

Screen-based smart device - iOS or Android

- a. For group play - a large monitor or setting up in the theater room is suggested.
- b. For individual play - any smartphone, tablet, or PC.
